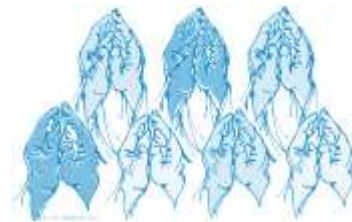
Pictorial Church Directory

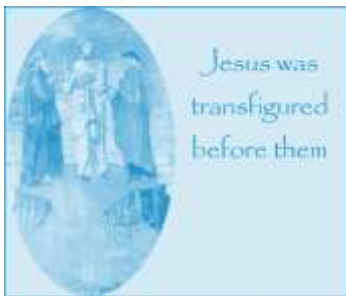

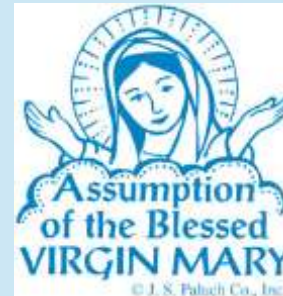
