

Dear Friends.

I'm happy to welcome this weekend **Aaron Dixon**, our new music director! Aaron will be teaching in our beautiful school as well as coordinating music for our Masses. He will work with the cantors, the choir, the schola, and our kids' choir. He is quite talented at the organ and I know we will all appreciate his gifts! Richard and Curtis will continue to play the organ as well, and Mrs. Disser will continue to work in our school as a sub, help with our music at church, and she will also continue giving me private piano lessons!

**St. Anne's Altar Society** meets tomorrow, September 11th at 7:00 p.m. downstairs. Hope to see many of you women there. I will be baking some treats to share....and that is not easy for me! That's how much I want you there.

Youth Group kick-off is today. All high schoolers are welcome. 6:00 - 7:30 p.m. We'll meet by the basketball courts. We will discuss things like mission trips, service opportunities, youth trips, retreats, and so on. 





Informational meeting for permanent diaconate set for September 10th in Indianapolis.

The archdiocesan <u>Office of Deacon Formation</u> is beginning a period of inquiry and discernment for those interested in the permanent diaconate. In the Arch-

diocese of Indianapolis, formation for the permanent diaconate is a five-year process beginning with a year of inquiry and discernment.

The first year includes a series of monthly meetings, beginning in September and concluding in April, which are held in various locations around the archdiocese. The sessions are open to all those who wish to enter into discernment. Serious applicants are expected to attend all the meetings. If they are married, it is asked that their wives also attend.

Formal application packets will be distributed in January of the discernment year to those who have actively participated in the discernment process. The applications will then be reviewed by a selection committee, and those who are selected to enter formation will begin the formal four-year process in August 2018.

The first inquiry session will take place at 2:30 p.m. on September 10th at St. Lawrence Parish, 6944 E. 46th St., in Indianapolis. The topic will be the "Diaconate as Vocation," and will also discuss necessary qualifications and the four-year formation process. A finalized schedule of monthly meetings will be published soon.

No preregistration is required for these sessions, and each session will begin at 2:30 p.m. and end by 4:30 p.m. For more information, contact the archdiocesan Office of Deacon Formation at 800-382-9836, ext. 1492, 317-236-1492, or e-mail Deacon Kerry Blandford, archdiocesan director of deacon formation, at kblandford@archindy.org. †
