## From the Desk of Fr. Mike

Please take a moment to thank God for your blessings this Thanksgiving. I mean really thank him. He is the source of it all; it all comes from his bounty. What we are most deeply thankful for—it isn't money, or nice houses or cars or jobs. It's faith and family. May we never forget that. Amen and amen.

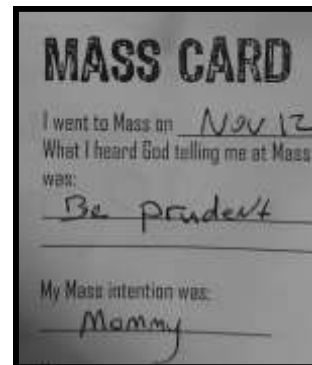
