

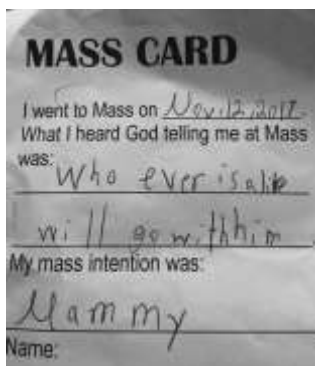

### Sr. Joan's Corner

Dear Parishioners,

We celebrate the Feast of Christ the King with a Gospel story that tells us what we need to do to be included in the Kingdom of Heaven. And the message is simple, but not always easy to do: Give food to the hungry, drink to the thirsty, shelter to the homeless, visit the imprisoned, etc.

We can only be healthy if we are giving away some of our riches to others. This should remind us that we need to give to the poor, not simply because they need it, though they do, but because unless we give to the poor we cannot be healthy. When we give to the poor both charity and justice is served, but some healthy self-interest is served as well. We cannot be healthy or happy unless we share our riches, of every kind, with the poor. The poor do need us, but we also need them.

Fr. Mike and I made a pastoral decision that in order to help our parishes and to help the poor of Shelby County our parishes should work together to form a local Conference of the St. Vincent de Paul Society. We have had an overwhelming response of people from both parishes who say they are interested in such a mission. I have invited Pat Jerrell from the Indianapolis Conference to come to St. Vincent Hall on **Tuesday, December 5th at 6:30 p.m.** to share with us what this will entail. I know there are many scheduling conflicts with this date. This is always a problem. I also believe that whoever can make it are the people who need to hear what is said. Others will be able to attend other meetings and do other ministries in the future. Anyone interested is welcome to attend.

This week as you pray with the Gospel reading, talk to Jesus, our humble King, about what He can help you spread His Word of love and share your wealth.

### Christmas Poinsettias

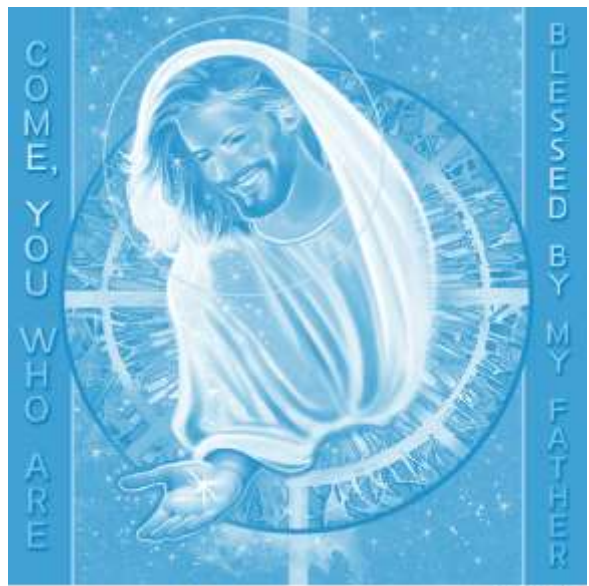
