From the Desk of Fr. Mike

Dear Friends,

Reverse Raffle thanks - I want to thank everyone for a very successful Reverse Raffle. I especially want to thank those who volunteered their time, donated items, and those who helped to match all the proceeds. All in all, we profited about \$100,000 (after the double), so we are thrilled. The monies will be used to put in new ceilings, fix leaks, and continue classroom renovations. The school is also used by our youth groups, faith formation groups, and so on. Special thanks to Erica Chudzinski, who won the \$2000 prize and donated it all back to the school! What a powerful example of generosity!!

Intention Weekend - This weekend is Intention Weekend. It is a time to make our pledges to the diocese. You may know that the diocese makes a video for this each year, and this year they profiled St. Joe! I am just thrilled. We will show the video downstairs after all Masses. It might make you shed a tear. Fr. Rodriguez makes a beautiful point in there. He notes that one beautiful thing about this campaign is that we don't personally know the people our money is helping. "Blessed will you be by their inability to repay you," as Jesus says.

New Worship Hymnals - At St. Joe, we will be getting new hymnals very soon to replace the Breaking Bread. Each year, we have spent \$3,500 or so replacing hymnals. The new hymnals will not need to be replaced each year. They will be hard cover books, with all the readings and hymns. All our organists were highly supportive of this idea. You can sponsor a book for \$25 and make it in memory of someone, and that would go in the front cover. Envelopes are in the pews and can be placed in the normal collection with the name on the outside and the \$25 on the inside.

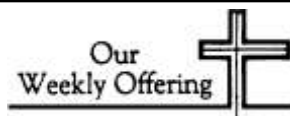
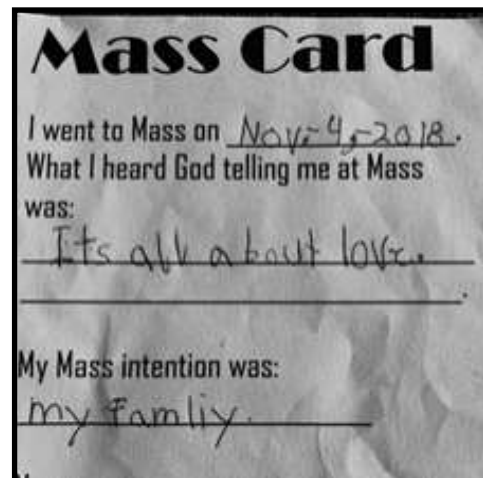
