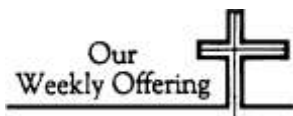

Dear Parishioners,

This weekend we celebrate the Feast of the Epiphany. We celebrate that Jesus came as a human being to all peoples. It is a very big celebration for the Sisters of St. Francis Oldenburg, IN. It is the day we celebrate because in 1850 Sister Theresa Hackelmeier left Austria, Germany by boat coming to the United States and made her way down the Ohio River to Cincinnati and arrived in Oldenburg, IN on January 6, 1851. There were 3 young women waiting for her to begin the new community of sisters. Fr. Francis Rudolf asked for Sisters to come to Oldenburg to teach girls and take care of orphans. Very shortly after arriving, they began those ministries. The community continued to grow to close to 1000 sisters in the mid-1960s. Today we have around 195 Sisters, with about 125 living at the motherhouse in Oldenburg and 235 Associates. This week as you take time to pray, pray for the Sisters of St. Francis and your own community of family and friends.

First Reading — Rise up in splendor, Jerusalem! The Lord shines upon you (Isaiah 60:1-6).

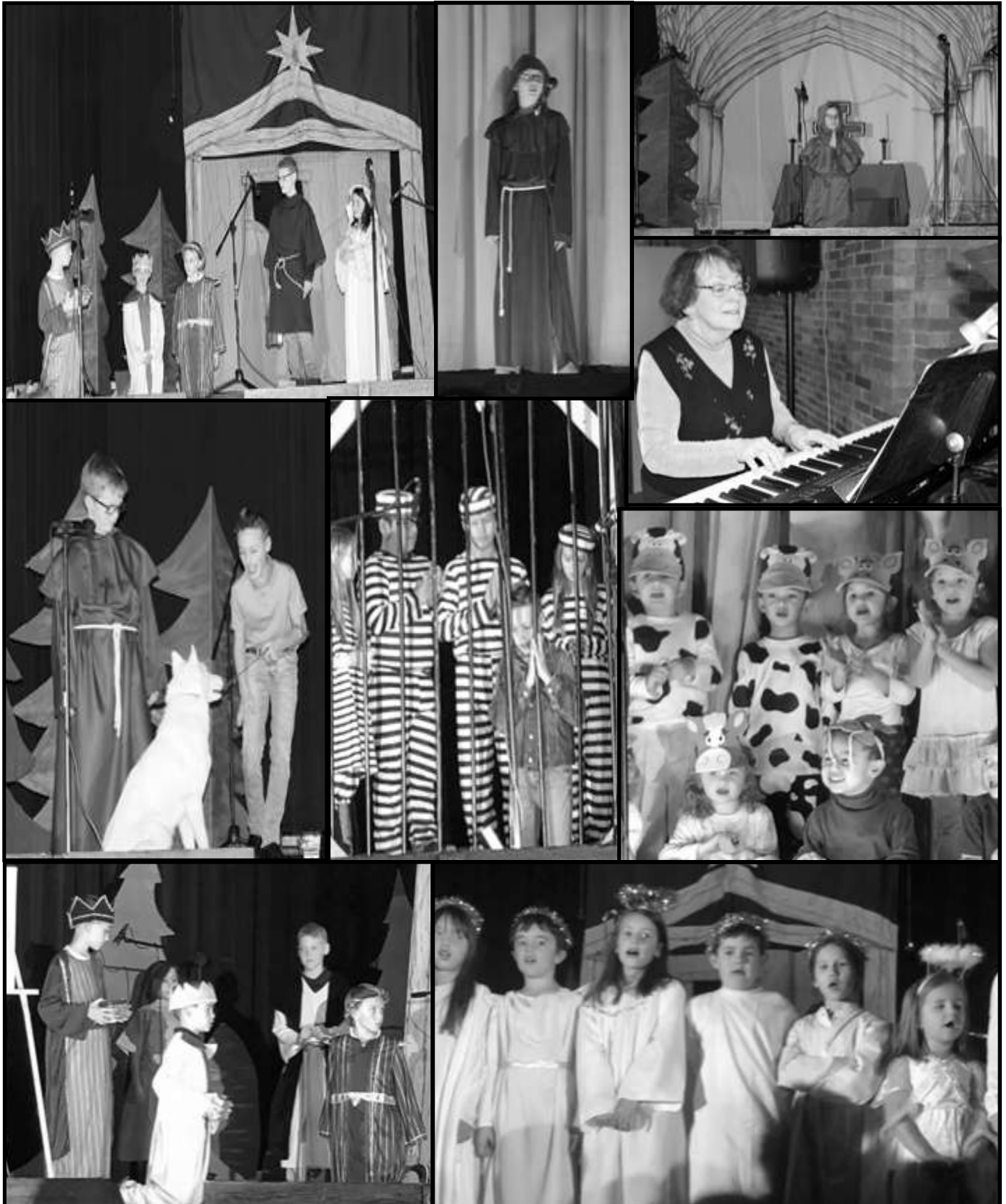
