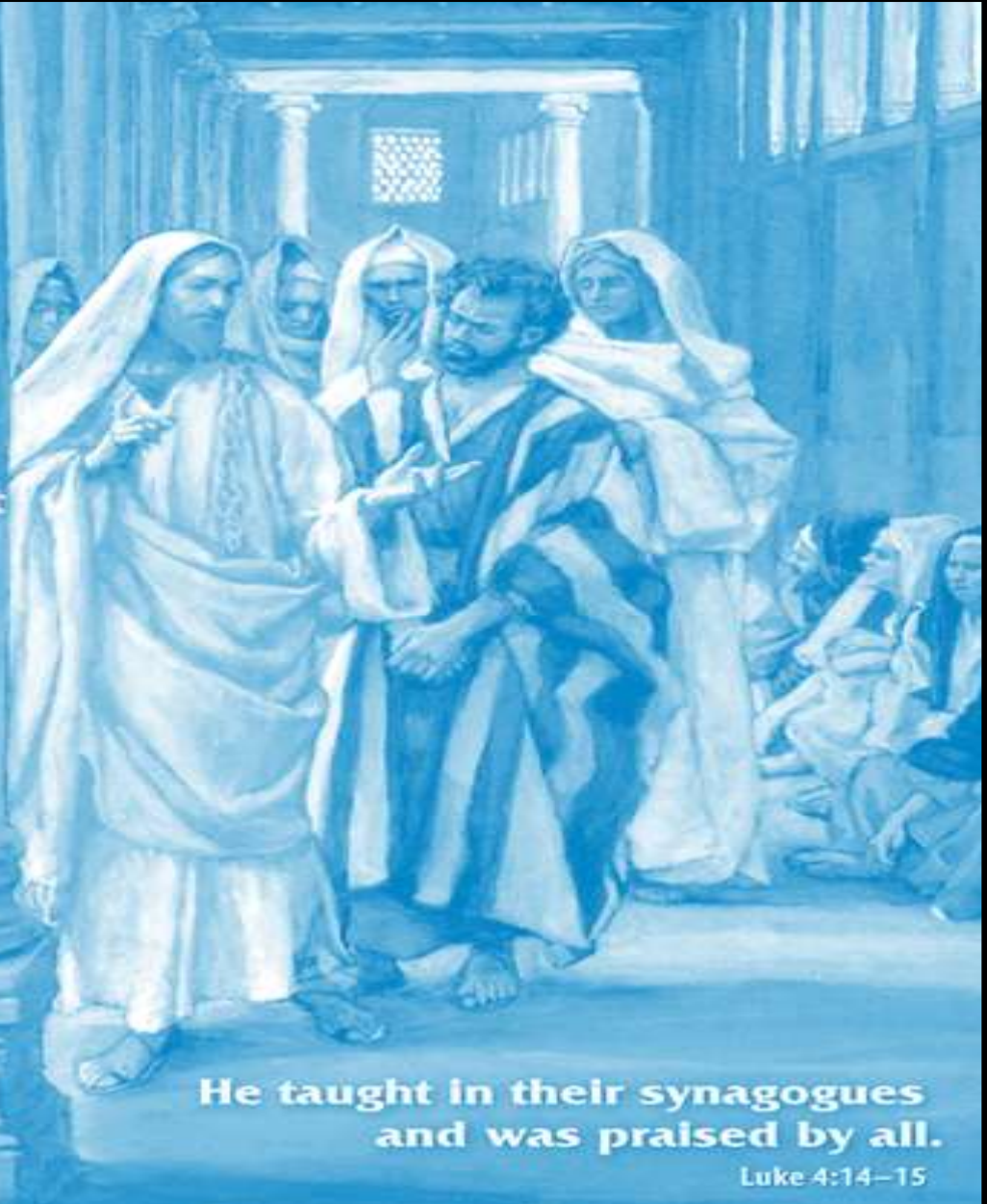

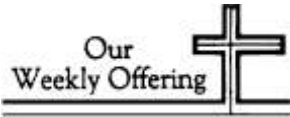

Sr. Joan's Corner

Dear Parishioners,

In this weekend's Gospel, we see Jesus back in his hometown preaching in the synagogue. Let's look at what has been happening in Jesus' life right up until this happened. Jesus was baptized by John the Baptist, then he went off for 40 days in the desert to fast and talk with his Father about what his mission on earth was to be. After his skirmish with the Devil, he returns to his hometown and on the Sabbath went to the synagogue as was his custom. He read from the scroll, "The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he has anointed me to bring glad tidings to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim liberty to captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to let the oppressed go free, and to proclaim a year acceptable to the Lord." Then he said, "Today this Scripture passage is fulfilled in your hearing. What Jesus read from the scroll is his Mission Statement. He spent the rest of his life living it out. This week as we talk to Our Father in prayer let us ask him what he wants us to do in our life. We might do it each day as we begin our day with prayer asking God to help us to know what God wants us to do that day and have the courage to do it. We may end up bringing glad tidings to the poor or sight to the blind in ways we don't expect
