From the Desk of Fr. Mike

Dear Friends,

St. Joe Feast Celebration - Well, folks, we are getting ready for the St. Joe Feast Celebration, coming up on March 2. I am excited for this! Remember that this will feature several different things. We've got the games for kids in the gym from 2-4 p.m., the procession at 4 p.m. (starts in the church), then Mass, and then dinner and band at the K of C. Last year, the dinner was downstairs in the cafeteria and the entertainment was at the K of C. Folks suggested that this year they both be there, so that's what we'll do. The dinner will be on the "restaurant side" and the entertainment will be in the Hall. There will be drinks available of course, and because of the beef raffle and the 50/50, kids are not allowed in the Hall. Keep that in mind. Kids are allowed, of course, on the dinner side. Hope to see everyone there. The beef raffle proceeds will support the St. Vincent de Paul Society. The rest of the proceeds support the entire parish—church, youth, school, etc.

February is a month set aside to remember the hidden life of Jesus. The majority of Jesus' life was hidden. Jesus lived with his parents in Nazareth, "under their authority" (Luke 2:51), and there "increased in wisdom, in stature, and in favor with God and with people" (Luke 2:52). As Henri Nouwen has noted, when we think about Jesus we mostly think about his words and miracles, his passion, death, and resurrection, but we should never forget that before all of that Jesus lived a simple, hidden life in a small town, far away from all the great people, great cities, and great events. Jesus' hidden life is very important for our own spiritual journeys. If we want to follow Jesus by words and deeds in the service of his Kingdom, we must first of all strive to follow Jesus in his simple, unspectacular, and very ordinary hidden life.

Valentine's Day - In honor of the patron saint of love, St. Valentine, we will have a special blessing over all married couples this weekend at the end of Mass.

Anointing of the Sick - In honor of Our Lady of Lourdes and invoking her healing power, we will have the Anointing of the Sick after Masses this weekend. More details on page 8.

My newest nephew - You might remember that my newest nephew, Paul, was born on Dec. 9, my birthday and the feast day of St. Juan Diego.

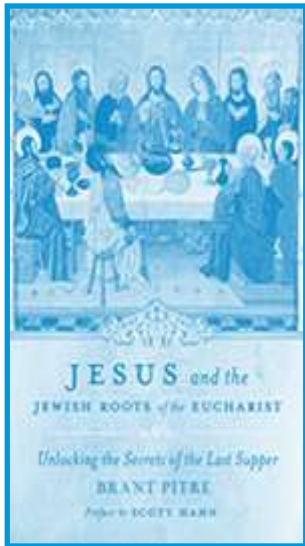

Anointing of the Sick after Weekend Masses- Feb 9/10

In the midst of the novena to Our Lady of Lourdes, patroness of the sick, the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick will be offered AFTER each of the four Weekend Masses. If you are ill or elderly you are welcome to receive this sacrament.

So, who may receive the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick?

The Code of Canon Law Reads:

Canon 998- *The anointing of the sick by which the Church commends to the suffering and glorified Lord the faithful who are dangerously sick so that He relieve and save them, is conferred by anointing them with oil and using the words prescribed in the liturgical books.*

Canon 1004- *The anointing of the sick can be administered to a member of the faithful who, after having reached the use of reason (age 7), begins to be in danger due to sickness or old age.*

2. *This sacrament can be repeated whenever the sick person again falls into a serious sickness after convalescence or whenever a more serious crisis develops during the same sickness.*

These canons can be summarized as follows:

Those who satisfy three conditions may be anointed:

1. A baptized Catholic,
2. Reached the age of reason (age 7),
3. Begun to be in danger from illness or the infirmities of age, or have become sick again or underwent a further crisis. It should be noted that the danger need only have begun to exist. The person does not have to be "in extremis" (in imminent danger of dying). This is a change from the pastoral practice before the Second Vatican Council.

The ritual book (the rite book) gives the following examples:

- "those who are dangerously ill through sickness or old age"
- "a sick person...before surgery whenever the surgery is necessitated by a dangerous illness"
- "elderly people...if they are weak, though not dangerously ill"
- "sick children...sufficiently mature to be comforted by the sacrament"
- "sick people who have lost consciousness or who have lost the use of reason...if ...they would have requested it if they had been in possession of their faculties"
