I remember when I was a junior high student my dad telling me that if I ever loaned money to any of my friends that I should not expect it back. I thought that was strange, because I knew what a loan was. As I live life, I know what wisdom there was in that advice.

Jesus, in this Sunday's Gospel is very clear in saying how he wants his follower to live. Many of us will have to have a total turn around in attitude. Jesus says "Love your enemies, do good to those who hate you, bless those who curse you, pray for those who mistreat you." How can we love without any return? "Lend money and expect nothing back," Jesus says. If you get a reward for each thing you do you are just like the pagans. 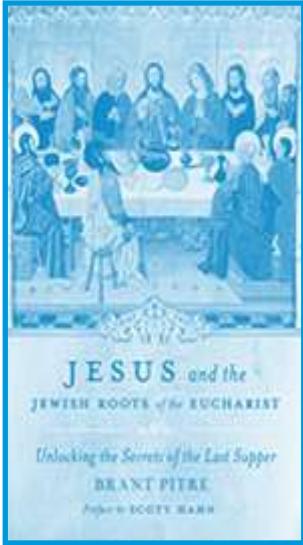
