Almsgiving, Prayer, Fasting and Temptation

As we begin our season of fasting, prayer, and almsgiving, the reading from Deuteronomy reminds us of our duty of almsgiving, that we "set [our offerings] before the Lord, [our] God, [and] shall bow down in [God's] presence" (Deuteronomy 26:10). The reading from Romans refers us to our prayer, reminding us that "The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart . . . For everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved" (Romans 10:8, 13). These are comforting words, and encourage us to ask God for what we need and to aid us in our prayer. Finally, the Gospel of Luke shows us a fasting Jesus, who was tempted as we are, and who knows what it means to be human. Someone once said that temptation arises when you're tired and weary, and the devil comes along and makes a perfectly reasonable suggestion. Jesus shows us that, with his help, we too can overcome our temptations, reasonable as they may sound.

Sr. Joan's Corner

Dear Parishioners,

This is the First Sunday of Lent. What is the meaning of Lent? Why do we set aside Forty days each year to voluntarily give up some legitimate enjoyments so as to prepare for Easter? Jesus in this Sunday's Gospel gives us an answer. Jesus is tempted by the Devil with three temptations that we all have. We are all tempted to have too many possessions, too much power thinking we can do things on our own and wanting too much prestige. Receiving ashes on our heads on Ash Wednesday is a reminder to take stock of ourselves. If we are living in the ashes we do not have many possessions, or much power or prestige.

In virtually every culture there is the concept of having "to sit in the ashes for a time" in preparation for a deeper joy. We see this in the story of Cinderella. The name itself holds the key: derived from Cinders, meaning ashes and Puella, the Latin for young girl. The name Cinderella means the eternal girl who sits in the ashes with the further idea being that, before she gets to put on royal clothes, go to the ball, and dance with the prince, she must spend some time sitting in the ashes, tasting some emptiness, feeling powerless, and trusting that this deprivation is necessary to help bring about the maturity needed to do the royal dance.

As we pray this First week of Lent, may we listen to Jesus tell us about how he was able to begin his Forty days in the desert and ask Jesus for help as we begin ours.

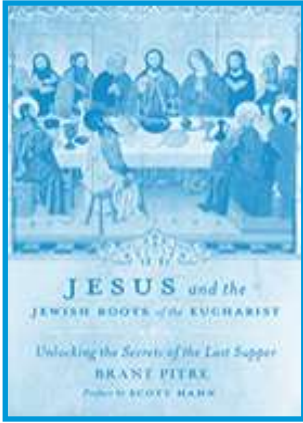
