COVERINGS—When you come into church this weekend, you will notice that the statues are covered. The 5th week of Lent until the Triduum is known as Passiontide. During these last days of Lent, we are to keep our hearts and souls united to the Lord in His passion. Statues are veiled to help us realize what it would be like to NOT have the fruits of the passion and resurrection of Jesus. If our Lord had not died and rose from the grave; there would be no saints, no images of the passion, no images of the sacred heart. The crosses/crucifixes and images of our Lord's passion will be unveiled at the celebration of our Lord's passion on Good Friday. The other images of the saints and images of our resurrected Lord remain veiled until the beginning of the Easter Vigil.

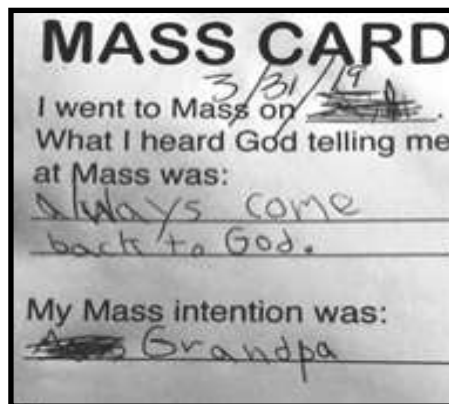

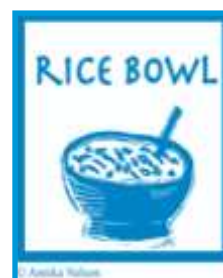
