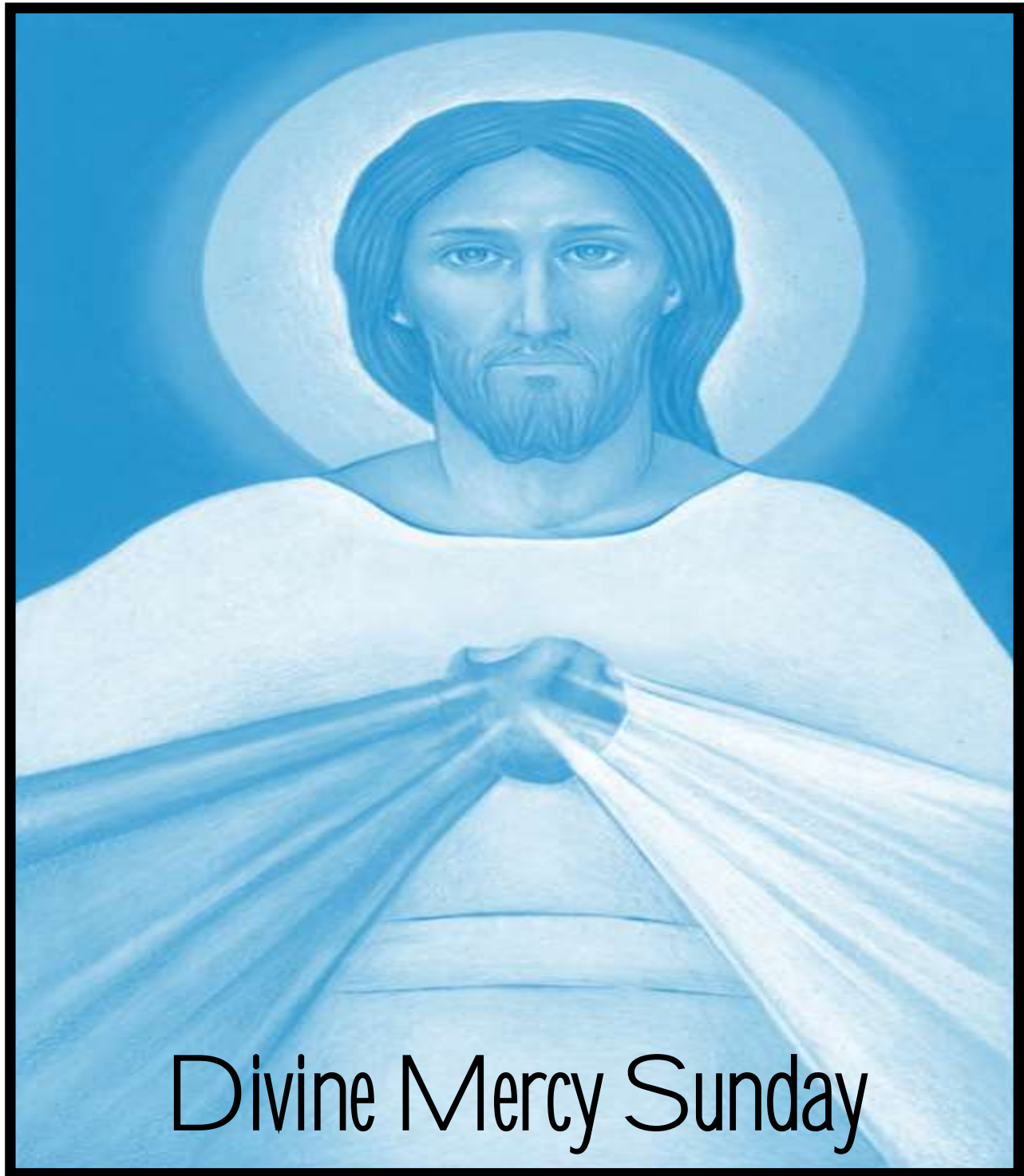

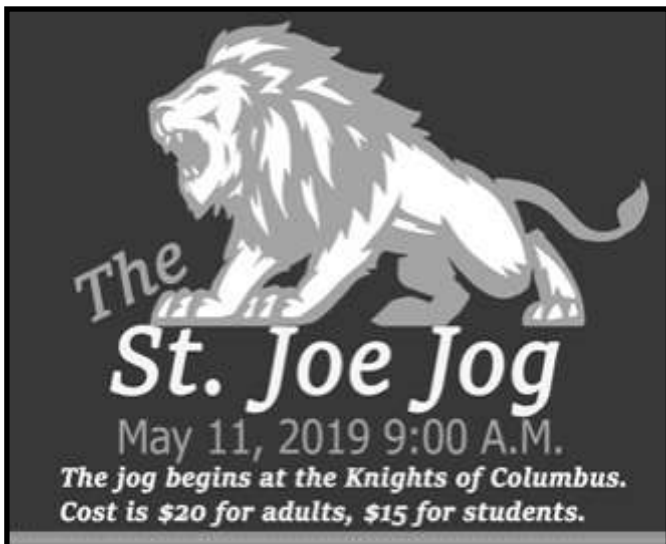

St. Joseph Parish Council March Action Points

1. Eagle Scout candidate Reid Schene spoke with the council about his Eagle Scout project, the outdoor sign on Broadway which currently lists Mass times. Reid is developing a new and improved sign together with parish leadership.
2. Fr. Mike updated the council about the parish survey, which, at the time of the meeting was underway by parishioners. The results of this survey will help us to establish goals and action items to advance our mission within the parish and the larger community. Many have already done this survey. The council's input was quite helpful in the putting together of this survey.
3. The council has been working for months to craft a parish mission statement that is both concise and descriptive, and more in line with our purpose. Tentatively, the mission statement is as follows: The mission of St. Joseph Parish is to be Christ in Shelby County through service, formation, worship, and celebration. Some of this verbiage will likely change. Please let us know if you have any input.
4. St. Joseph discussed a potential new program for two year old children through St. Joe School. This program would be offered mornings only, a few days a week. Amy Kuhn developed a proposal for this. Some work must be done to the bathrooms and classroom space, but fortunately we have a grant for \$25,000 to do the bathrooms and we will apply for another grant for the classroom space, contingent upon approval by school board, parish council, finance council, and the pastor. The council heard this proposal favorably.
5. The council discussed again the coming adoration chapel (the Chapel of Divine Mercy). Fr. Mike shared that much work is being done to prepare the space and that, thanks to a grant and some anonymous donors, the chapel will not cost the parish anything. There is much enthusiasm for the chapel. Signups will begin the weekend of April 27/28. Opening date is June 23, Corpus Christi Sunday at 3 p.m. This will be a HUGE blessing for our parish.

As always, we also discussed ministry reports. Please let me know if you would like any more information or would like to bring anything before the council.
