May is one of the months we set apart to honor Blessed Mother. We have crowned Mary at both St. Vincent and St. Joseph. At St. Joseph, the school kids crowned the outdoor statue in what was a beautiful ceremony. The FFF kids crowned the indoor Mary because it was raining outside.

How to Pray the Rosary

Hold the Cross—pray the **Apostle's Creed**

1. Our Father bead—pray the **Our Father** for Pope Francis
2. Three Hail Mary beads—pray **3 Hail Mary's** for an increase in Faith, Hope, and Love
3. Glory Be
4. Next, it's time for the **five mysteries** (depends on the day—see below). Each mystery is:
 - a. One Our Father
 - b. Ten Hail Mary's
 - c. One Glory Be
 - d. Fatima Prayer (*O My Jesus...*)
5. After praying all the mysteries, pray the **Hail Holy Queen**
6. Then close with the **closing rosary prayer**: *O God, Whose Only Begotten Son....*

If you don't know one of the above prayers, it's time to learn! Just do a Google search.

Below are the mnemonic devices that I sometimes use when teaching kids who have a hard time remembering the different mysteries. The best way to learn the mysteries is to pray the Rosary DAILY.
