## Weekly Collection Need Increase

Most parishes increase their collection need each fiscal year. Last year, we worked hard not to have to do that. Consequently, our weekly collection need at St. Joe has been \$14,200 for the past two years. This fiscal year, we had to increase our weekly need to **\$14,500**. Costs and salaries go up every year, so this covers those expense increases. The good news is, your salaries have also gone up! So, if your salary has gone up, your Sunday tithe should also. ## Charitable Giving

Have you wondered how you can get more from your IRA? If you are 70 ½ or older, you can give up to \$100,000 directly from your IRA. Your rollover gift must be made directly to St. Joseph Church from your IRA and come directly from the IRA to St. Joseph. The charitable rollover generates neither taxable income nor a tax deduction, so you still benefit even if you do not itemize your taxes. If you have not taken your required minimum distribution for the year, your IRA charitable rollover gift can satisfy all or part of that requirement. Your IRA charitable rollover can be designated for St. Joseph, St. Joseph School, the United Catholic Appeal, as well as the Catholic Community Foundation fund, to benefit a Catholic ministry. Please be sure to inform Rebecca at the parish office of your gift ahead of time so we will know the rollover is from you.

This weekend Jesus tells us a story to illustrate how we are to live if we want to be his follower. The story of the Good Samaritan is very familiar to most of us. The whole scene begins with a scholar asking Jesus what he must do to inherit eternal life. We are not to go to the other side of the road to avoid others who may need our help. The "neighbors" may be our own family, people who have just moved into the neighborhood, or strangers we meet on the street.

This week as we pray, we may think of how we meet people. Do we see them as Jesus sees them? Ask Jesus to bless those folks that you want to avoid.

Above & Below: Here is our sister parish, Our Lady of Guadalupe, located in the Quiche department in Guatemala in the city of Chel. It takes about two hours on very rocky roads to get here. The Jeep you see in this photo was the only car in Chel, which Fr. Mike and some others used to get to the city. Chel is an example of the many poor pueblos in Guatemala, with a population of about 2000 people. There is little electricity and water here. The parish is fairly small on account of a massacre of Catholics 37 years ago, who were shot and thrown into the river that flows by the town. The parish continues to try to recover from that. Fr. Mike had the joy of offering several Masses and hearing plenty of confessions here during the trip, along with meeting with parish leadership there about how we can help. He ate all but one of our meals at parishioners' homes.
