Sr. Joan's Corner

Dear Parishioners,

In the first reading this weekend Abraham sets a high standard of hospitality as he epitomizes godly generosity and graciousness to strangers. He is sitting in the hot sun and sees three distant strangers. Without fear, he jumps up and welcomes them, begging them to honor him with their presence. He offers them precious water, choice meat, and fresh baked bread. What motivated him? Abraham knew from the Torah that God often visits in the guise of the traveler or foreigner. Move through history a thousand years and we see Martha and Mary offering hospitality to Jesus. There are many interpretations of the Martha and Mary story, but what is clear is this: It may be Martha's house, but Jesus is the actual host. Mary may be listening to his words like a disciple, but Jesus demands that his disciples be attentive to both the Word and to service. God still shows us God's face in the stranger and alien. It is now two thousand years later, as we pray this week think about how we treat the stranger. Are we welcoming or are we too afraid to be hospitable? Think about a time when you thought that you were doing someone else a favor and realized later that it was you who received the greater gift. Pray that we can welcome all who come into our lives with Christian hospitality

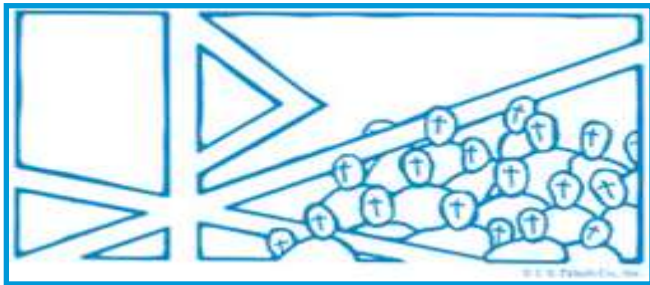
Psalm — He who does justice will live in the presence of the Lord (Psalm 15).

Charitable Giving

Have you wondered how you can get more from your IRA? If you are 70 ½ or older, you can give up to \$100,000 directly from your IRA. Your rollover gift must be made directly to St. Joseph Church from your IRA and come directly from the IRA to St. Joseph. The charitable rollover generates neither taxable income nor a tax deduction, so you still benefit even if you do not itemize your taxes. If you have not taken your required minimum distribution for the year, your IRA charitable rollover gift can satisfy all or part of that requirement. Your IRA charitable rollover can be designated for St. Joseph, St. Joseph School, the United Catholic Appeal, as well as the Catholic Community Foundation fund, to benefit a Catholic ministry. Please be sure to inform Rebecca at the parish office of your gift ahead of time so we will know the rollover is from you.



Treasures From Our Tradition

A Mindset of Service

There's a lot of traveling, delivering, and visiting going on in our readings today. In Genesis Abraham cares for the needs of three mysterious travelers. The psalm responds, celebrating the kind of righteousness that Abraham practices. Then, in his letter to the Colossians, Saint Paul describes his own ministry as almost like a delivery service: he, God's steward, brings the word of God to their community. Finally, Luke's Gospel shares the well-known story of Mary and Martha, and the different ways they welcome Jesus into their home. Amid all this coming and going, we are invited to pay attention to the ways we tend to the needs of others. Each of us can ask, *How am I present to God and others in my life?*
